All monies raised for India Covid appeal were held in our banks and what remains has been set aside for supporting this ongoing cause in the LPS' origins area of South Gujarat and shown as a liability . Raised £59000 including HMRC Gift aid (£7890) and including LPS London pledge of £5001 approved by Trustees . The spend to date is £25878 leaving £38126.
